

# How does your garden grow?

## Family Learning Project

Choose tasks to complete with your child and then send them into school between:

24.04.17 - 19.04.17

### 1 House Point

- ◆ There are 10 seeds waiting to grow in a flowerpot. If 4 seeds start to grow, how many are still waiting to grow?
- ◆ Go for a walk with a grown-up around a garden or a park. Make a list of the plants and flowers that you see.
- ◆ Draw a picture of some flowers. What colours do you need?

### 2 House Points

- ◆ There are 18 petals on a flower. If 6 drop off, how many would be left on the flower?
- ◆ 'Sunflower' is a very long word for a very tall flower! What other words can you think of that start with this sound to do with the garden?
- ◆ Paint a picture of some flowers. What colours do you need?

### 3 House Points

- ◆ Can you write your own garden maths problem?
- ◆ Use the letters in the word 'sunflower', what other words can you make?
- ◆ Make a model of a flower. Think about how you could make the stem, the flower and the leaves.
