In Year 2 SATs 2017, PP Premium underperformed compared to non PP children in all areas. By targeting Teaching Assistant support this year, we are looking for the gap to close.

We have several children in Year 1 and 2 with emotional needs and these are being addressed by our Nurture Assistant so that the children are ready to learn.

PP funding is also being used to expand the life experiences of all children by subsidising visits.

The current Year 3 group showed underachievement of PP children compared to non PP children. There are several children in this class with emotional and behavioural issues. PP funding is being used to pay for a TA to provide nurture and 1-1 support.

The current Year 6 class showed a difference in Maths achievement between PP and non PP children. By maintaining high Teaching Assistant levels across school, we are able to support children who need it to close the gap.

Due to limited extra curricular experiences, PP funding is also used to subsidise educational visits and residential.

Persistent absence has been an issue in the past with pupils eligible for Pupil Premium. We are now working with Attend to Achieve and current persistent absence for PP children, as of 24th May, is:
8/186 Whole School Population = 4%
8/59 Pupil Premium Population = 13.5%

Whole school persistent absence stands at $24/186 = 12.9\%$ including 2 children on Part Time timetable or $22/184 = 11.9\%$ excluding these children.
