



## Primary Physical Education and Sports Funding - Plans for 2020-2021

**Amount of Grant expected - Approx £17,480** (Money Carried forward from 2019-2020 COVID - £3773)

**Total Funding: £21,253**

Government guidance found at <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/pe-and-sport-premium-for-primary-schools#coronavirus-covid-19-update> states that this funding should be used in the following 5 ways (Key Indicators):

1. Engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity
2. Profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
5. Increased participation in competitive sport

2	Purchase/install Bike/Scooter storage to encourage active travel to and from school	£500 (£0)	This needs investment next year.
2	Attendance at SUAT Cluster meetings for Coordinator	£500 (£0)	This was achieved virtually. Academy budget used.
3	External CPD for Staff to increase confidence teaching PE (focus areas: Gymnastics; Outdoor & Adventurous Activities; Dance).	£1500 (£300)	Training took place in Gymnastics and Outdoor Adventurous activities. Training opportunities limited by COVID 19.
3	Internal CPD for staff to increase confidence teaching PE	Academy Budget	Termly staff meetings delivered. Positive feedback from staff.
4	Use external sports providers to offer alternative sporting clubs	£2000 (£0)	This was not possible due to Pandemic.
4	Use external sports providers to offer enrichment experience days	£1500 (£0)	This was not possible due to Pandemic.
5	Participate in increased sporting events locally	Release Time if needed	This was not possible due to pandemic.
5	Offer to host events here for the local sports cluster	Release Time if needed	Offer made but this was not possible due to pandemic.
4	Install, resourcing and staff training for Orienteering Course	£999	This was decided upon for enrichment; pandemic reduced opportunities to visit external providers.
4	Improvements to indoor gymnastics equipment	£944.64	This was completed to improve Gymnastics provision.

Review notes:

- The impact of COVID 19 and additional closures/control measures affected spending decisions considerably
- Money spent focused on improving facilities within school and purchasing equipment to improve lesson/playground/afterschool provision which we ourselves could offer, rather than making use of external providers
- Impacts of spending are extremely positive and monitoring has demonstrated improved staff confidence, improved experiences for pupils and increased participation in physical activity and after school club provision
